

**CITY OF ANTELOPE**  
**ORDINANCE NO. 168**  
**AN ORDINANCE PROTECTING WATER PURITY, CREATING OFFENSES AND**  
**PENALTIES, PRESCRIBING ENFORCEMENT AND JURISDICTION.**

The City of Antelope does ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. FINDINGS OF FACT. The City hereby adopts the following finding of facts:

- (A) The purity of the City water supply is threatened by certain types of activity within the municipal watershed, water reservoir and water system.
- (B) The City of Antelope has been extended Jurisdiction over the municipal watershed, water reservoir and water system and empowered to enact this ordinance by ORS 448.300

SECTION 2. ACTS CONSTITUTING OFFENSES.

- (A) After the effective date of this ordinance the following acts, posing such a threat, are hereby declared to be offenses and are henceforth prohibited in the municipal watershed, water reservoir and water system.
  - 1. The unauthorized disposal of trash, garbage or other debris at the Solid Waste Transfer Station.
  - 2. The disposal of any toxic chemicals, sewage, dead animal carcasses, tires, large appliances, vehicles or explosives.
  - 3. Littering or disposal of trash, garbage or debris outside of the Solid Waste Transfer Station.
  - 4. The use of the Solid Waste Transfer Station by any person which violates any city ordinance or resolution, state law or regulation or federal law or regulation.
  - 5. The unauthorized setting or maintaining of fire within the watershed, water reservoir and water system. Fire within the municipal watershed, water reservoir and water system shall only be authorized by the Council and shall only be authorized if it is consistent with state laws

and regulations and/or federal laws or regulations.

6. Hunting, trapping, camping or picnicking.

7. The running of livestock, including horses, or abandoning any animal.

8. The discharge of firearms.

9. The unauthorized use of any motor vehicle.

(B) For each offense either a knowing, reckless or careless mental state shall suffice.

### SECTION 3. ENFORCEMENT.

(A) Pursuant to ORS 448.315 the Mayor or the Watermaster may appoint special police to enforce this ordinance.

(B) Jurisdiction over violations of this ordinance shall be in accordance with ORS 448.320.

### SECTION 4. PENALTIES.

(A) Any person who violates this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$300.00 for each day of violation.

(B) In prosecuting violations of this ordinance, violations may be treated as infractions by the prosecutor.

SECTION 5. SAVINGS CLAUSE. Any cause of action under Ordinance No. 168 is hereby saved.

SECTION 6. The foregoing ordinance was passed this 11th day of November, 2003 by the following vote of the Antelope City Council.
